WORD

What's the difference between knowing something intellectually and knowing something experientially? How has this related to our personal knowledge of God?

How have you come to know God better recently?

As a group, list as many ways as you can think that we can come to know God better (through Bible reading, prayer, other Christians, nature, His working in circumstances, etc). How can group members relate to any of these personally?

How has coming to know the hope of His calling changed your outlook on life?

How can knowing we have the same power that raised Jesus from the dead at work in us change our approach to life's challenges?

WORSHIP

Find a song related to this week's theme and listen to it or sing it together.

MEMORY VERSE

'I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.' (Ephesians 1:17)

PRAYER

Let's invite the Holy Spirit to bring greater revelation to us now.

Holy Spirit, will You speak to us now about hope.

Holy Spirit, will You remind us of some of the riches You have placed in our lives because we belong to Christ.

Holy Spirit, will You give us a fresh revelation of how vast Your power is.

Give each person a phrase from the memory verse below. Mix up the order so it isn't sequential.

Everyone stands and starts repeating their phrase. Explain that while continuing to speak they need to get in the right order for the phrases to make up the memory verse. When in the right order they say, in sequence, their phrase, completing the memory verse.
